Friday 14th of February

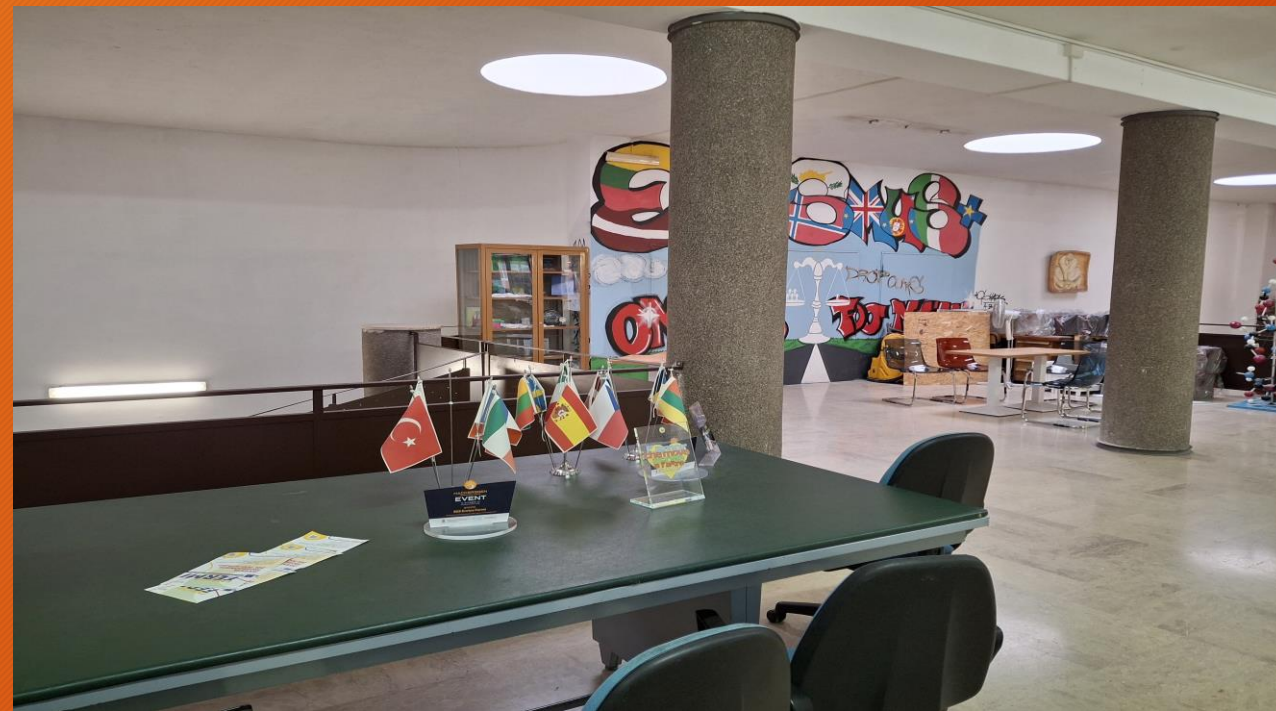
- Observation as well as cooperation in teaching biological themes about health and nutrition.

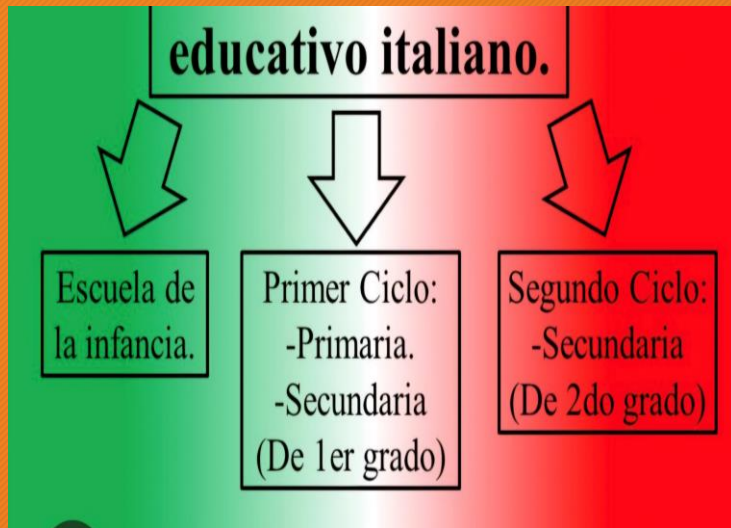
